

Daily log

October 13th

Evening flight with Ethiopian Airlines from Oslo and Stockholm.

October 14th

Arrival in Addis Abeba early morning and later flight to Antananarivo, where we landed early afternoon. Once through after visa and passport control we met Zina and Fidy at the airport. We stayed at Hotel Le Pavilion de l'Emyrne.

October 15th

Early breakfast and then heading north towards Ankarafantsika NP. Long trip; left 05:40 and arrived at Asity Lodge 20:40 (15 h!). Stop for birding in Ankazobe area 08:00-08:30 (Malagasy Harrier) and at bridge crossing Betsiboka river 16:30-17:00 (Madagascar Pratincole). Warm day with +35 °C.

October 16th

Ankarafantsika NP. Breakfast 06:30, departure at 07:00. Temp +33 °C. Met our local guide Fenodavy Gildas. Morning birding until lunch successfully searching for Van Dam's Vanga and Whitebreasted Mesite. Back for lunch at the lodge, siesta. Birding and watching Coquerel's Sifakas around headquarter (HQ) in Ankarafantsika in the afternoon. We split into two groups and did boat tours at Lake Ravelobe; stunning views of Madagascar Jacana and the rare Madagascar Fish Eagle. Night walk 18:15-19:30 with lots of good species.

October 17th

Ankarafantsika NP. Morning birding 06:15-08:45 successfully searching for Schlegel's Asity. Went north one hour by bus to a lake, but habitat mostly destroyed by local farmers and fishermen.

Afternoon 15:30-18:00 birded Baobab trail and near Lake Ravelobe. Night walk 18:15-19:15.

October 18th

We were served coffee and tea and left early at 04:15 towards Mahajanga and the Bombetaka Bay/Betsiboka Delta, bus trip took 3 hrs and 50 minutes. Boat tour in the delta 08:30-14:30, had some problems with low tide on the way back. Late lunch in Mahajanga and then back to Asity Lodge where we arrived at 19:30.

October 19th

Long transport today. Left Asity Lodge at 04:00, arrival in Tana at 18:30, hotel Le Chalet des Roses.

October 20th

Long transport day again, too long ... Started at 05:00 from Tana, arrived to Hotel Cristo in Ranomafana at 22:00 (17 hours!). We were not aware of that this road has been much worse during the pandemic ... We stopped for a nice breakfast and also for lunch and to (successfully) look for Madagascar Snipe.

October 21st

Today we were rewarded with a fantastic full day in Ranomafana NP, (almost) without rain! Breakfast at 06:00, met our local guide Diamondra and his two skilled coworkers. Spent the day in the park walking in wonderful forest until 16:00. Night walk 18:15-19:30. Among several highlights was the close views of a Brown Mesite, and a pair of Pollen's Vanga with a juvenile. Other highlights were Red-bellied Lemurs and Golden Bamboo Lemurs (a species that was discovered as late as in 1985).

October 22nd

Another full and fantastic day in Ranomafana NP. Among several highlights were Blue Coua, Pitta-like Ground Roller, Rufous-headed Ground Roller, the odd insect Giraffe-necked Weevil, Lowland Streaked Tenrec, and Small-toothed Sportive Lemur. Fidy was lucky to see a Fanaloka crossing the trail.

October 23rd

Wake up at 03:30, left Hotel Cristo 04:10. Despite packed breakfast and lunch the bus trip back to Tana took us 15 h. Stayed at Hotel Les Trois Metis.

October 24th

Tana to Andasibe, started at 07:00, arrived at Grace Lodge in Andasibe at 12:00. Lunch 13:30. Met our local guides Cris and Agati for a nature walk in the very nice V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve 14:30-17:45. Highlights were a Madagascar Flufftail at close distance, a sleepy Rainforest Scops Owl, stunning views of a family (2 adults and 2 juveniles) Nuthatch Vanga, Madagascar Starlings, and our first 6 Indris.

October 25th

Woke up at 04:45. Transport in four 4-wheel drive jeeps to Mantadia NP. Wonderful day in the forest. Among several highlights: Madagascar Harrier-Hawk, Madagascar Rail, Short-legged Ground Roller, Scaly Ground Roller, Tylas Vanga, White-throated Oxylabes, Gray Bamboo Lemur, and the Critically Endangered Black-and-white Ruffed Lemur.

October 26th

Breakfast at 04:30, transport in our 4WD's to Iharoka forest (unfortunately only 5 of 11 in the group joined the long walk today). Spent a full day – 12 h – in the field. As during the whole trip we were pleased with good weather. Despite visiting a nest we were disappointed to dip the Helmet Vanga, but were compensated with stunning views of a pair of the rare Bernier's Vanga and Madagascar Cuckoo-Hawk, as well as Common Sunbird-Asity and Forest Rock Thrush.

October 27th

Breakfast at 06:00, departure 06:45 to Analamazoatra Reserve, Andasibe NP. Had a pleasant pizza lunch at a restaurant in Andasibe. Highlights: Madagascar Ibis, Red-breasted Coua, Collared Nightjar (a very odd species; song unknown), Eastern Woolly Lemur, Indri, and Diademed Sifaka.

October 28th

Breakfast at 06:00, visited V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve 07:00-10:15. Had a last lunch at Grace Lodge and then heading towards Tana, where we stayed at hotel Le Chalets des Roses. Highlights: Madagascar Sparrowhawk, Henst's Goshawk.

October 29th

Breakfast at 05:15. Birding in Tsarasaotra Park, Tana 06:30-09:00. Had lunch at a restaurant and then transport to the airport. Flight to Addis at 14:35, and again at 23:50 towards Europe. Highlights: Malagasy Pond Heron.

October 30th

Arrival in Stockholm and Oslo.

We recorded 137 species of birds 14-29th October. rd = along road.

The subspecies are in most cases assigned based on the above list rather than by morphological characters noted in the field.

Ducks, Geese & Swans Anatidae

White-faced Whistling Duck Dendrocygna viduata Up to 50 in Ankarafantsika 16–17.10, 30 Betsiboka Delta 18.10, 3 rd 24.10, and c. 200 Tsarasaotra 29.10.

Knob-billed Duck *Sarkidiornis melanotos* 2 Tsarasaotra 29.10.

Blue-billed Teal *Spatula hottentota* 10 Tsarasaotra 29.10.

Red-billed Teal *Anas erythrorhyncha* 2 rd 15.10, and c. 200 Tsarasaotra 29.10.

Guineafowl Numididae

Helmeted Guineafowl *Numida meleagris* Up to 10 in Ankarafantsika 16–17.10. Note: Introduced species.

Pheasants, Grouse, and Allies Phasianidae

Harlequin Quail *Coturnix delegorguei delegorguei* 2 *en route* to Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Grebes *Podicipedidae*

Madagascar Grebe *Tachybaptus pelzelnii* (VU) Endemic

1 Lake Ravelobe 16.10 (not seen by all).

Flamingos *Phoenicopteridae*

Lesser Flamingo *Phoeniconaias minor* c. 50 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Ibises, Spoonbills Threskiornithidae

Malagasy Sacred Ibis *Threskiornis bernieri bernieri* 6–8 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Note: ssp. abbotti occur at Aldabra I, Seychelles.

Madagascar Ibis Lophotibis cristata cristata (NT) Endemic

1 Analamazoatra Reserve 27.10.

Note: Decreasing population trend, currently 6,700 mature individuals, according to IUCN.

Herons, Egrets, and Bitterns Ardeidae

Little Bittern *Ixobrychus minutus podiceps* 1 Mantadia 25.10.

Black-crowned Night Heron *Nycticorax nycticorax nycticorax*

2 rd 19.10, 5 rd 20.10, and c. 20 Tsarasaotra 29.10.

Striated Heron *Butorides striata rutenbergi* 5 rd 15.10, and 1+1 Ankarafantsika 16–17.10.

Squacco Heron *Ardeola ralloides*Up to 30 Ankarafantsika (Lake Ravelobe) 15–17.10, 4 rd 20.10, 2 rd 24.10, and c. 50 Tsarasaotra 29.10.

Malagasy Pond Heron Ardeola idea (EN) Endemic 4 Tsarasaotra 29.10.

Western Cattle Egret *Bubulcus ibis*Common to fairly common, noted on most days.

Grey Heron *Ardea cinerea firasa* 1 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Humblot's Heron *Ardea humbloti* (EN) Endemic 11 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Goliath Heron *Ardea goliath* 1 near Tana 14.10 (HP only).

Purple Heron *Ardea purpurea madagascariensis* Up to 2 Ankarafantsika (Lake Ravelobe) 16–17.10, 1 Betsiboka Delta 18.10, and 1 rd 20.10 and 23.10.

Great Egret *Ardea alba melanorhynchos*Common to fairly common, noted on most days, often *en route*.

Black Heron *Egretta ardesiaca*Up to 10 noted on 6 days, often *en route*; c. 10
Tsarasaotra 29.10.

Dimorphic Egret *Egretta dimorpha* Common rd 14.10, noted in Betsiboka Delta 18.10, rd 24.10, and c. 50 Tsarasaotra 29.10.

Hamerkop Scopidae

Hamerkop *Scopus umbretta umbretta* 2 rd 20.10, and 1 rd 24.10.



Madagascar Cuckoo-Hawk (TC)

Kites, Hawks & Eagles Accipitridae

Madagascar Harrier-Hawk Polyboroides radiatus Endemic

1 Lake Ravelobe 16.10, 1 Betsiboka Delta 18.10, 1 rd 19.10 (c. 133 km from Tana), and 2 Mantadia 25.10.

Madagascar Cuckoo-Hawk Aviceda madagascariensis Endemic 1 Iharoka 26.10.

Madagascar Sparrowhawk Accipiter madagascariensis (NT) Endemic 2 seen perched at close distance, Andasibe 28.10. **Henst's Goshawk** *Accipiter henstii* (NT) Endemic 1 heard Analamazoatra Reserve 27.10, and 1 seen briefly 28.10.

Malagasy Harrier *Circus macrosceles* (VU) Endemic 2 males c. 16 km S Ankazobe 15.10, and 1+1 male seen *en route* 19.10.

Note: Endemic to Madagascar & Comores

Yellow-billed Kite *Milvus aegyptius parasitus* Up to 10 seen daily 15–20.10, and 1 29.10.

Madagascar Fish Eagle Ichtyophaga *vociferoides* (CR) Endemic

1 Lake Ravelobe 16.10.

Note: Earlier in genus Haliaeetus.

Madagascar Buzzard *Buteo brachypterus* Endemic Totally 10 noted during 6 days: 1 15.10, 2 16.10, 2 17.10, 1 22.10, 3 23.10, and 1 25.10.

Mesites Mesitornithidae

White-breasted Mesite Mesitornis variegatus (VU) Endemic

2 seen + 1 heard Ankarafantsika 16-17.10.

Brown Mesite *Mesitornis unicolor* (VU) Endemic Superb views of 1 in Ranomafana 21.10.

Flufftails Sarothruridae

Madagascar Forest Rail Mentocrex kioloides kioloides Endemic

3 Ranomafana 21.10, and 1 Analamazoatra Reserve 27.10.

Note: English and genus name changed from Madagascan Wood Rail *Canirallus kioloides*.

Madagascar Flufftail Sarothrura insularis Endemic Superb views of 1 (+ 1 heard) at V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve, Andasibe NP 24.10. Note: Too close, down to 1 m, and too fast to take photos!

Rails, Crakes & Coots Rallidae

Madagascar Rail *Rallus madagascariensis* (VU) Endemic

Short but good views of 2 in Mantadia NP 25.10.

White-throated Rail *Dryolimnas cuvieri cuvieri* 1 Analamazoatra Reserve 27.10, and 1 at V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve 28.10.

Common Moorhen *Gallinula chloropus pyrrhorrhoa* c. 10 Tsarasaotra 29.10.

Plovers and Lapwings Charadriidae

Grey Plover *Pluvialis squatarola* 2 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Common Ringed Plover Charadrius hiaticula tundra

1 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Greater Sand Plover *Charadrius leschenaultia scythicus*10 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Jacanas Jacanidae

Madagascar Jacana *Actophilornis albinucha* Superb views of 1 at Lake Ravelobe 16.10.

Whimbrel Numenius phaeopus 10 Betsiboka Delta 18.10. Curlew Sandpiper Calidris ferruginea c. 50 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Sanderling *Calidris alba* 5 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Little Stint *Calidris minuta* 1 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Madagascar Snipe Gallinago macrodactyla (VU) Endemic

1 at a roadside wetland close to Reserve Villageois d'Ankazomivady 20.10.

Terek Sandpiper *Xenus cinereus* 5 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Common Greenshank *Tringa nebularia* 10 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Pratincoles and Coursers Glareolidae

Madagascar Pratincole Glareola ocularis
10 Betsiboka River 15.10, and 3 at the same place
19 10

Note: Breeds only in Madagascar, migrating to E Africa during austral winter.

Gulls, Terns & Skimmers Laridae

Lesser Crested Tern *Thalasseus bengalensis bengalensis*

c. 30 Betsiboka Delta 18.10.

Pigeons and Doves Columbidae

Rock Dove *Columba livia* Noted in towns, e.g. 15.10 and 17.10.

Malagasy Turtle Dove *Nesoenas picturatus picturatus*

Totally 12 noted during 7 days: 3+3 Ankarafantsika 16–17.10, 2 rd 20.10, and in Andasibe/Mantadia 1 24.10, 1 25.10, 1 27.10, and 1 28.10.

Namaqua Dove Oena capensis aliena 1–2 seen daily 15–19.10, often along the road. **Madagascar Green Pigeon** *Treron australis xenius* Endemic

3+1 Ankarafantsika 16-17.10.

Madagascar Blue Pigeon Alectroenas madagascariensis Endemic 2+2 Ranomafana 21–22.10.

Cuckoos Cuculidae

Malagasy Coucal Centropus toulou toulou
Totally 27 noted during 10 days (1 to 6 daily). First
4+6 Ankarafantsika 16–17.10, also seen in
Ranomafana NP and Andasibe/Mantadia.
Note: Endemic to Madagascar and Aldabra.

Crested Coua *Coua cristata dumonti* Endemic 2 Ankarafantsika 16.10.

Blue Coua *Coua caerulea* Endemic 2 Ranomafana 22.10, 1 Analamazoatra Reserve 27.10, and 2 V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve, Andasibe NP 28.11.

Red-capped Coua *Coua ruficeps ruficeps* Endemic 1 ad with 1 juv Ankarafantsika 16.10.

Red-fronted Coua *Coua reynaudii* Endemic 1 Ranomafana 21.10.

Coquerel's Coua *Coua coquereli* Endemic 1 Ankarafantsika 16.10.

Red-breasted Coua *Coua serriana* Endemic 1 Analamazoatra Reserve 27.10.

Madagascar Cuckoo Cuculis rochii Most often heard, but some seen. First heard 16.10. Noted as common almost daily 20–28.10.

Barn-Owls Tytonidae

Western Barn Owl *Tyto alba hypermetra* 1 seen at Grace Lodge, Andasibe 26.10. (JW, KL).

Owls Strigidae

Rainforest Scops Owl *Otus rutilus* Endemic 1 at V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve, Andasibe NP 24.10.

Nightjars and Allies Caprimulgidae

Collared Nightjar *Gactornis enarratus* Endemic 1 Analamazoatra Reserve 27.10.

Madagascar Nightjar Caprimulgus madagascariensis madagascariensis Noted on six days, often heard but also seen: 1 17.10, 1 18.10, 1 19.10, 2 25.10, 2 26.10, and 2 27 10

Note: Endemic to Madagascar and Aldabra.

Swifts Apodidae

Madagascar Spinetail Zoonavena grandidieri grandidieri

1 Mantadia NP 25.10 (TC).

Note: Endemic to Madagascar and Comoros.

Malagasy Palm Swift Cypsiurus gracilis Totally 102 noted during 13 days 15–28.10 (normally 5–10 per day).

Note: A recent (2019) split from African Palm Swift *C. parvus*. This taxon is endemic to Madagascar and Comoros.

Malagasy Black Swift Apus affinis affinis 5 in Tana 14.10.

Note: Endemic to Madagascar and Comoros.

Cuckoo-Roller Leptosomidae

Cuckoo Roller *Leptosomus discolour discolour* 3+2 Ankarafantsika 16–17.10, 1 Ranomafana 21.10, and 1 Mantadia NP 25.10.

Rollers Coraciidae

Broad-billed Roller *Eurystomus glaucurus glaucurus*

2+8 Ankarafantsika 16–17.10, and 2+2+2 Andasibe/Mantadia NP 24–26.10.

Ground Rollers Brachypteraciidae

Short-legged Ground Roller *Brachypteracias leptosomus* (VU) Endemic 1 Mantadia NP 25.10.

Scaly Ground Roller *Geobiastes squamiger* (VU) Endemic

1 Mantadia NP 25.10.

Pitta-like Ground Roller *Atelornis pittoides* Endemic

2 Ranomafana 22.10.

Rufous-headed Ground Roller *Atelornis crossleyi* (NT) Endemic

1 Ranomafana 22.10.

Kingfishers Alcedinidae

Madagascar Pygmy Kingfisher Corythornis madagascariensis madagascariensis Endemic 1+1 seen during nightlightning in Ankarafantsika 16–17.10, 1 Ranomafana 21.10, and 1 at V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve, Andasibe NP 24.10.

Malagasy Kingfisher *Corythornis vintsioides vintsioides*

2 rd 15.10, 1+1 Ankarafantsika 16–17.10, 1 Analamazoatra 27.10, and 2 Tsarasaotra 29.10. Note: Endemic to Madagascar and Comoros.

Bee-eaters Meropidae

Olive Bee-eater *Merops superciliosus superciliosus* 10 rd 15.10, 1 Ankarafantsika 17.10, 1 rd 19.10, 5 rd 23.10, 3 24.10, and 3 Mantadia NP 25.10.

Hoopoes Upupidae

Madagascar Hoopoe *Upupa marginata* Endemic 2+1 Ankarafantsika 16–17.10 and 1 rd 18.10.

Falcons and Caracaras Falconidae

Malagasy Kestrel Falco newtoni newtoni 24 noted during 7 days. First 2 rd 14.10 and 10 15.10, 2 19.10, 5 20.10, 2 21.10, 2 22.10, and 1 28.10.

Note: Endemic to Madagascar and Aldabra.

Old World Parrots Psittaculidae

Greater Vasa Parrot *Coracopsis vasa drouhardi* 1 Betsiboka River 15.10, and 3 Ankarafantsika 17.10.

Note: endemic to Madagascar and Comoros.

Lesser Vasa Parrot *Coracopsis nigra libs* Endemic 6+2 Ankarafantsika 16–17.10, 1+1 Ranomafana 21–22.10, 1 V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve, Andasibe NP 24.10, 4 Iharoka 26.10, and 1 V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve, Andasibe NP 28.10.

Grey-headed Lovebird *Agapornis canus canus* Endemic

10 rd 15.10, and 7 at Lake Ravelobe 17.10.

Broadbills *Eurylaimidae*

Velvet Asity *Philepitta castanea* Endemic 1 male and 3 females Ranomafana 21.10, and 1 male Iharoka 26.10..

Schlegel's Asity *Philepitta schlegeli* (NT) Endemic Stunning views of a pair in Ankarafantsika 17.10.

Common Sunbird-Asity *Neodrepanis coruscans* Endemic

2 males Iharoka 26.10.

1 Ranomafana 21.10.

Hook-billed Vanga *Vanga curvirostris curvirostris* Endemic

2 Ankarafantsika 17.10.

Bernier's Vanga *Oriolia bernieri* (EN) Endemic Stunning views of a pair at Iharoka 26.10.

Van Dam's Vanga Xenopirostris damii (EN) Endemic

2 males and 1 female Ankarafantsika 16.10.

Pollen's Vanga *Xenopirostris polleni* (NT) Endemic Male and female with a juvenile Ranomafana 21.10.

Sickle-billed Vanga *Falculea palliata* Endemic 4+1 Ankarafantsika 16–17.10.

White-headed Vanga Artamella viridis viridis Endemic

1 heard V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve, Andasibe NP 28.10.

Chabert Vanga *Leptopterus chabert chabert* Endemic

2 Ankarafantsika 17.10, 1 V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve, Andasibe NP 24.10, and 3 Mantadia NP 25.10.

Madagascar Blue Vanga Cyanolanius madagascarinus Endemic 2 Ankarafantsika 16.10, and 1 Iharoka 26.10. Note: New English name after split from Comoros Blue Vanga *C. comorensis*.

Rufous Vanga *Schetba rufa* Endemic 4+2 Ankarafantsika 16–17.10, and 2 Ranomafana 21.10; ssp. *occidentalis* W Madagascar, nominate N & E Madagascar.

Tylas Vanga *Tylas eduardi eduardi* Endemic 2 Ranomafana 21.10, and 1 Mantadia NP 25.10.

Nuthatch Vanga *Hypositta corallirostris* Endemic Stunning views of male and female with 2 juveniles at V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve, Andasibe NP 24.10, and 3 Mantadia NP 25.10.

Dark Newtonia *Newtonia amphichroa* Endemic 1 Iharoka 26.10.

Common Newtonia Newtonia brunneicauda brunneicauda Endemic
Often heard, several seen, common to fairly common in forests (Ankarafantsika, Ranomafana, and Andasibe/Mantadia NP).

Cuckoo-shrikes Campephagidae

Stripe-throated Jery *Neomixis striatigula* Endemic 1 V.O.I.M.M.A. Community Reserve, Andasibe NP 24.10, 8 Analamazoatra 27.10, and heard 28.10. Note: HBW/Birdlife split this taxon into Stripe-throated Jery *Neomixis striatigula* and Subdesert Jery *N. pallidior* (in SW Madagascar).

Madagascar Cisticola Cisticola cherina 6 rd 15.10, 1 rd 19.10, 1 rd 20.10, and 2 rd 23.10.Totally c. 35 noted during 10 days (2-19/11), first 5 *en route* (2/11).

Note: Endemic to Madagascar and S Seychelles.

White-eyes Zosteropidae

3 Ankarafantsika 17.10, and totally 32 noted on 8 days 21–28.10 (2–10 daily).

Souimanga Sunbird Cinnyris sovimanga sovimanga Fairly common to common almost every day (11 days). Most often heard only, but several seen. Note: Endemic to Madagascar and some islands north of Madagascar, e.g. Aldabra is. Five subspecies recognized.

and Comoro Is, which it may have colonized
without human assistance.
